DECISION

CASE OF SAAKASHVILI v. GEORGIA

(Application no. 54641/21)
introduced on 10 November 2021

The European Court of Human Rights, sitting on 10 February 2022 in a single-judge formation pursuant to Articles 24 § 2 and 27 of the Convention, has examined the application as submitted.

The application refers to Article 3 of the Convention.

The Court notes that the conditions set out in Article 37 § 1 of the Convention for striking out the application are fulfilled. Furthermore, the Court finds no special circumstances relating to respect for human rights as defined in the Convention and the Protocols thereto which requires it to continue the examination of the application.

The Court *decides* to strike the application out of its list of cases.
